Items

Banana

Can be placed on the track, causing the vehicle that runs over it to spin out of control.



Bullet Bill

Transforms you into a Bullet Bill, which automatically follows the course at high speed.



Blooper

Obscures the view of the drivers ahead 00 of you.



Chases the vehicle in front of you, knocking over the first vehicle it hits.



Lightning Makes all opponents spin out of control,

shrinks them and lowers their speed. Super Star

Spiny Shell

vehicles.

Chases the vehicle in first place, knocking over any vehicles it hits.



Grants temporary invincibility, allowing you to knock over opponents. Your speed also increases

Bob-omb Explodes when thrown or dropped, knocking over or spinning out nearby



Fire Flower

Allows you to throw fireballs using \square/\bigotimes . Fireballs cause vehicles they hit to spin out.



Dash Mushroom

Provides a short speed boost.



Super Leaf

Makes your vehicle grow a tail, which you can attack with using L/(X).



Golden Dash Mushroom

For a short time, allows you to use a Dash Mushroom whenever you press L/X.



Lucky Seven

Equips seven items simultaneously.



Local Multiplayer

Up to eight players can play (requires at least one MARIO KART™ 7 Game Card and as many Nintendo 3DS systems as players). One of the players with a Game Card creates a group, and the other players ioin that group.

Note: Players without a Game Card can join via Download Play.




Creating a Group

Player with a Game Card

- From the main menu, select LOCAL MULTIPLAYER, then CREATE A GROUP.
- Once all participating players' names are displayed, select START.
- Follow the on-screen instructions.





Joining a Group

- From the main menu, select LOCAL MULTIPLAYER, then the name of the player whose group you wish to join.
- Follow the on-screen instructions.
